

in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men.

But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, <u>not willing that any should perish</u>, <u>but that all should come to repentance</u>.

2 Peter 3:3-9

but God would not leave me with an unwillingness to obey.

Through a crazy dream the Lord brought me to a place where I said, "OK, Lord! If you ask me to forgive, I will forgive." There couldn't be anything I was unwilling to do and still pledge my undying love to my husband. There was no question about Jerry's faithfulness, but I had to be willing to face anything that God allowed me to go through in order to keep my vow.

What have you vowed? What have you promised? What have you spoken that has not been fulfilled? We can justify ourselves all day, but our words are what clearly justifies or condemns us, not our justification.

This has not been a generation that can be trusted to keep their word. We see this in the family, in the church and in the government. What we see in the government is what has come from our homes. Every man and woman in the government were raised by a family. It all starts at home. One of the most destructive works of Satan has been his work in the home. Divorce has been accepted as a way to solve all problems. It has never solved a problem but has created multitudes of heartaches. The church has done a very poor job of dealing with this issues.

Divorce happens!!! There are victims of divorce. If your partner wants to break their vow, you cannot make them stay. There are victims. Did they have responsibility in the destruction of the home? You will not find a perfect person, and yes both parties have responsibility, but when one refuses to work on the problem, the other becomes a victim. We have not loved the victims as God would have loved them. We have not always been there for the children who are victims.

We also have not helped those who have broken their vows, to come to repentance. We join them in their sin by justifying their actions due to

the situations. Christianity does not work off of situations. It works by right and wrong, good and evil. We justify our breaking of God's Word because someone sinned against us. God doesn't judge us by what someone else does, but by our words we are justified or condemned.

If you have suffered because of the breaking of your word or the breaking of someone else's word, remember God is our life and He can restore all things. A humble and contrite heart He will not despise.

The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. Ps 51:17

I am so thankful that God's Word has been tried and it is true. But we have a problem with sin and we do not always follow through on our words to others. If you have been broken or wounded because of broken words, you need to do one of two things. Either ask forgiveness for yourself or forgive the other person. You may have to do both in order to get right. We fail. God does not fail, but He does restore. Praise the Lord.

Before we speak, remember, we are justified or condemned by the words that come from our lips!!!

WHAT WAS THAT YOU SAID?

A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things.

But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.

For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

Matt 12:35-37

What was that you said? Often we speak without thinking. If it's really true that a woman speaks more than a man, then we have more words to give an account for. Although, I'm not sure we talk more than the man. Most of the man's words are spent talking about how much the women talk!

Have you ever stopped to think about the fact that you will give an account to God for every idle word! If this is not enough to scare you, then stop and think about the fact that each word we speak either justifies, or condemns us. Every word that comes out of our mouth is bringing judgment to our life. It's a sobering thought, is it not? Every word we speak reveals our hearts. Do you really think that you are hiding those thoughts in your heart? You are not. They are revealed by the word, by the tone of the word and by the intent of the heart concerning that word.

I admit, I am a talker. Before I was saved I was very backward, but the moment I was saved, life was so wonderful that I could not learn about it fast enough. I have a question and an answer for everything in life. My daddy told me once that when I died, they would have to keep my coffin closed for three days. I asked, "Why?" He said, "Because you will be talking three days after you're dead." I must have been getting on his nerves about that time! The secret is not to quit talking, but to make sure our words are words that justify us, and not words that condemn us.

What is it that we love so much about God? We can trust His Word!

As for God, his way is <u>perfect</u>: the word of the LORD is <u>tried</u>: he is a <u>buckler</u> to all those that trust in him. Ps 18:30

For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.

Ps 33:4 Ps 119:140

Thy word is very pure: therefore thy servant loveth it. Ps 119:14

Would you trust God today, if yesterday He didn't keep His Word? No! You would not. Yet how many times have we spoken and did not follow through with our words. We will give an account for that. What if others try our words? Will they find those words spoken in truth? Can they trust our words to be right? Will our words be a buckler to those who trust us?

We are living in a throw away generation. Think of all the paper items you have in your home; paper plates, plastic silverware, napkins, paper towels, toilet paper, Kleenex, etc. We don't use a repair man very much anymore; we just throw away whatever broke and buy a new one. We don't repair our lives anymore like we once did; we just throw it away and think we can make it new. Life is not like our material goods. You have ONE life and you do not throw it away,. It remains with you until death. Oh, you may think you have started a new

life, but the old one stays with you. Thank goodness our sins are gone when we repent and trust the work of Christ for our life, but we must deal with whatever we created by our words, our works and our actions. Once the Holy Spirit is sealed in our hearts, then He begins to work on us to purge out all the things we have wrongly built in our lives, but if we resist Him, we continue in our own destruction.

How do you pay your bills? You gave your word to pay those bills, did you not? Have you read your church covenant? When you joined your church, you agreed to abide by that covenant. Are you? When you married, you made a vow. Are you living in harmony with that yow?

I grew up knowing that marriage was to be until death!!! I went into marriage thinking that I would be married forever. I spoke those vows as my daddy said, "Repeat after me." I said, "In sickness and in health. In poverty or wealth. Until death do us part." This is what the audience heard me say. What they did not hear me say was, "I will stay married until you are unfaithful!" I had no intention of living with an unfaithful man. But I was vowing until death. In my heart I had put a stipulation on my vow. I didn't mean what I was saying. I told Jerry before we married, that if he was ever unfaithful to be me, I would forgive him, because God required me to forgive him, but he just couldn't live here any longer! 

THE UPS AND DOWNS OF LIFE!

I have taken the ladies of our church to many ladies' meetings. While we were riding down the road we would share stories of our lives with each other. Of course, I told more stories on Jerry than on myself (wouldn't you if you were me?). The ladies have begged me to write a book about our falls, but I just haven't had the courage. I thought today would be a good time to give every one a good laugh at our expense.

Before I start with Jerry's falls, I must admit that I have had my own embarrassing moments. I remember teaching a ladies' seminar at a mission conference in East Texas. I had taught all morning and the Lord had work greatly in the hearts of the ladies. I was on cloud nine! I finished my class right before lunch, so I picked up all of my materials and headed for the car, which was parked at the front of the building. As I got halfway across the parking lot, my ankle turned and I spread myself all over the parking lot. I must have slid several feet. I took all the hide off of my legs and arms, but somehow that wasn't what was important at that time. My first thought was, "How many people just watched the flying teacher go across the asphalt?" I finally got the nerve to look up and when I did, I realized that no one saw me fall!! Out of almost 300 people, no one saw me fall. My next thought was, "Nobody even cares that I'm lying on the ground!" Self pity stormed in like a lion. There was no one there to help me up. I liked to have never gotten up off the ground. Blood was running down my legs and arms (it really wasn't bad, but it looked bad). Finally, I got up and put my books in the car and walked into the fellowship hall (where everyone was but me) and looked around and realized that the world didn't even stop for my problem. How can I sit there hurting and no one even cared?

As soon as Jerry realized I had fallen, he began tending to me as a nurse would her child. The Lord taught me something that day. The truth is, many people sit around us today, who are bleeding and hurting and we don't know it. Maybe they fell into sin and are bleeding because of it.
