DOES JESUS CARE?

Have you ever wondered, "Does Jesus care?" I have! Sometimes when we pray, it seems that our prayers hit the ceiling and go no further. Job certainly understood what that was like. Job went a long time waiting upon the Lord to answer his prayer. The Lord was there all the time, but Job couldn't prove it to himself or his friends. The Lord was not only there, but He was on Job's side of the issue, yet He remained silent

until the work was completed.

Then there are the other times, when it seems that the Lord answers before we even call. I have been reminded lately of the caring hand of the Lord in my life over these 49 years that I have looked to Him as my Saviour, my Deliver, my Judge, my Tower of Protection, and my Shepherd who daily leads the way. I have been reminded of the compassion He has shown to my life in the middle of the troubles He has allowed in my life.

Years ago, when the Lord was moving Jerry into the position of the pastorate of the church, the Lord allowed us to go through great testing for ten months. It was financial testing, physical testing and by the end of ten months, it was mental testing. All of these testings produced great spiritual testing. At one time I had been going from hospital to hospital so many days without rest, that I had not been able to do laundry and I had nothing to wear the next day, and no time to wash unless I gave up much needed sleep. I didn't know what I was going to do. I walked to the mailbox to get the mail and found a package from Mrs. Martha Green (Bro. Roloff's secretary). It was a skirt and blouse with a note that read, "I was cleaning out my closet and thought you might be able to wear these. Love, Martha!" They fit perfectly. I said, "Lord", "you knew all the time what I would need today. You do care, don't you!"

Years later, I was on visitation with Mrs. Bobbie Mayhew, and we were talking about how the Lord provides for His children. We were driving on Central Expressway in Dallas, in the middle of traffic, in the far left lane, when all of a sudden my back tire blew! I told Bobbie to hang on, and I went across two lanes to the exit and rolled down to a service station. I picked up my cell phone and called my husband, who was all the way across town, and as he answered, my phone beeped in with another call. I asked Jerry to hold and when I answered the other call, it was my oldest son, Tom. He said, "Mother, where are you? Did you just have a blow out on your back tire?" I said, "Yes! How did you know?" He said he was right beside me when it happened and he realized it was me. He turned around and changed my tire and we were on our way in just minutes!!! Dallas is a large city and that could not have been an accident. Yes, God does care about the little things in our life.

The day the doctor told my mother that she had cancer, I began to really realize how much I missed my sister who had died the year before. I cried that week like most people would have cried at the death. I was having a pity party one morning that week and I told the Lord that it wasn't fair because no one would be there to comfort me one year after her death. Who could know what I was going through a year later? I walked to the mailbox (once again), and there was a sympathy card from Bro. Randy Langford. He had just learned that week that my sister had died, so he sent a card as if it had just happened, and it just happened to be when I needed it. Does Jesus care and does He know how to show He cares at the right moment? Oh yes, He most certainly does!

But the most recent express of the Lord's love for my life has been overwhelming. The Lord has really gone all the way to show His love for my life. My sister will have been gone three years this December. It has been a very hard

time for my brother-in-law and my three nieces. It is such an adjustment to lose a loving family member and nothing can ever replace them. The emptiness they leave behind needs to be filled. not by just anyone, but by someone who fits with the family that already exist. My brother-in-law began taking a lady to supper and they began building a friendship, but I was concerned because her life was not built upon the same foundation has ours. I began to pray for Jim. I knew he was lonely and I knew he needed someone to care for. He was a wonderful husband to my sister. Not long after I began to pray, he stopped seeing this friend. We were going to supper together one night and he told us he was not going with this friend any longer and there was a lady at our church that he wanted to meet. When he described her, I couldn't figure out who he was talking about. The next Sunday night he came to the church and pointed her out. I couldn't believe who he had picked!

When my sister died, this lady, Barbara Everitt, had come to my aide and had helped me with my mother. My mother loved her like a daughter. I could call Barbara anytime and she was always there to help like my sister would have done, had she been alive. We had even eaten meals together with Jim and he had never noticed her until this time. Barbara had been single for 33 years and was not looking for a husband, but when Jim saw her and she knew he had picked her out, God gave Barbara a different heart, and in no time we all knew they would be married.

Both Jim and Barbara's children were in favour of the marriage and with their consent the marriage was set for July 24, 2009.

Because Barbara is such a close friend of my life, I am not loosing my close relationship with my brother-in-law and my nieces. I have a cousin that is like a sister to me and now we have a friend who will be a sister to us. I could never have done or thought to


ANECDOTES FROM THE PULPIT by Charles H. Spurgeon (from Lectures to his students)

It ought never to be forgotten that the great God Himself, when He would instruct men, employs histories and biographies. Our Bible contains doctrines, promises and precepts; but these are not left alone - the whole Book is vivified and illustrated by marvelous records of things said and done by God and by men. He who is taught of God values the sacred histories, and knows that in them there is a special fullness and forcibleness of instruction. Teachers of Scripture cannot do better than instruct their fellows after the manner of the Scriptures.

Our Lord Jesus Christ, the great Teacher of teachers, did not disdain the use of anecdotes. To my mind it seems clear that certain of His parables were facts and, consequently, anecdotes. May not the story of the prodigal son have been a literal truth? Were there not actual instances of an enemy sowing tares among the wheat? May not the rich fool who said, "Take thine ease," have been a photograph taken from life? Did not Lazarus actually figure on the stage of history?

Certainly the story of those who were crushed by the fall of the tower of Siloam, and the sad tragedy of the Galileans, "whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices," were matters of current Jewish gossip, and our Lord turned both of them to good account. What He did we need not be ashamed to do. That we may do it with

Ez 16 (Part two)

SHE TRUSTED IN HER OWN BEAUTY

We found last month that after the Lord took Jerusalem as His bride, He washed, cleaned and dressed her, and then He said she was "exceeding beautiful," Why? Because of His work and His comeliness which He placed upon her.

And thy renown went forth among the heathen for thy beauty: for it was perfect through my comeliness, which I had put upon thee, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezek 16:14

The heathen saw her as beautiful. The definition of renown is 'a mark or memorial of individuality with honor, authority and character'. She was ready to be used of God to draw the lost to Christ. She was ready to be an help meet to her husband and His kingdom. She was the bride of the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. Her husband owned everything and knew everything and had the all power to do anything she needed. Her husband was LOVE! He didn't just know how to love, He was LOVE itself. He was righteousness and she never had to worry about being mistreated. She had it all!

How many times do we say, "If things were just different, I would be what I ought to be." We are fooling ourselves if we think that circumstances would cause us to be a better person. Circumstances reveal us, they don't make us! Our lives do not depend upon what we posses. It depends upon who we are in our hearts and who is truly "Lord" of our lives. Look what this woman does.

But thou didst <u>trust in thine own beauty</u>, and playedst the harlot because of thy renown, and pouredst out thy fornications on every one that passed by; his it was.

And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon: the like things shall not come, neither shall it be so.

Thou hast also taken thy fair jewels of my gold and of my silver, which I had given thee, and madest to thyself images of men, and didst commit whoredom with them,

And tookest thy broidered garments, and coveredst them: and thou hast set mine oil and mine incense before them.

My meat also which I gave thee, fine flour, and oil, and honey, wherewith I fed thee, thou hast even set it before them for a sweet savour: and thus it was, saith the Lord GOD.

Ezek 16:15-19

This woman thought it was her own beauty that had brought her such honor! Her trust was in herself, not the Lord. What happened? She was clean

now. She could hold her head up high as others passed by. Her clothes showed that time, effort and money had been spent on them and it showed someone cared about her. Her jewelry must have been attractive and she must have looked like royalty which made her think she was someone special. She forgot who she was before the Lord came into her life.

This woman took the things her husband had given her and used them to buy the love of the world. Her job was to bring the world to her husband (Christ), not to leave her husband for the world. If she had brought them to Christ, everyone could have had life. We are to make a difference in the lives of the lost and bring them into life, not to become polluted with their ways. If she had brought them to Christ, everyone could have enjoyed what she had, but she took of the good things and spent them in vain. She didn't help the world and she left herself empty.

Not only did she give away her beauty, but she lost her relationship with her husband. Why would she look for someone else when she had everything a woman could ever desire? She was deceived!!! She was looking for self satisfaction. She wasn't thinking of serving His life, but she was thinking of being served by others. Who did she hurt? She did damage to her husband. She brought disgust to the world and she left herself looking ugly to all, including herself! But that's not all.

Moreover thou hast taken thy sons and thy daughters, whom thou hast borne unto me, and these hast thou sacrificed unto them to be devoured. Is this

He came in contact with us two years ago after receiving one of our tracts in prison. We shared our information about him with a missionary who does Bible correspondence courses and Jerry has grown in the Lord through study of the Word of God while he remains in prison. He writes, "My prayers go out to you and all those whose lives Mrs. Rose Cimino has touched. Even though we prepare for the outcome and try to make everything as comfortable

as possible, the pain and sadness are still there. I have come to know your family over these years and what I have learned from you all is to put and keep your faith in the Lord. His glory shines through every situation." God can use this man where he is to bring others to the saving knowledge of the Savior. Our lives are a testimony to others, no matter where we are. We will either bring a person closer to the Lord or we will drive them away from Him by our actions and words. May we strive to honor and glorify the Lord in all that we do and say.

Tracts have gone forth as well as song books and the leaflet that tells of Dick Cimino's conversion from the Roman Catholic Church to the saving knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. We have to trust the Lord takes His Word and sends it forth where it is intended to reach the lost. Occasionally we hear of blessings or results which makes the hours of labor worthwhile. The tract is the biggest help to a missionary on the field and is within itself a silent missionary. It never tires, or gets sick, or discouraged. It never needs a furlough, or salary, or a building. The Vestal And The Bracelets

Most men think because God hath blessed them with an estate therefore they are blessed. Alas! God often gives these things in anger. He loads his enemies with gold and silver: as Plutarch reports of Tarpeia, a vestal nun, who bargained with the enemy to betray the Capitol of Rome to them in case she might have the golden bracelets on their left hands, which they promised; and being entered into the Capitol, they threw not only their bracelets but the bucklers, too, upon her, through the weight whereof she was pressed to death. God often lets men have the golden bracelets of worldly substance, the weight whereof sinks them into hell. Oh, let us get our eyes "fixed" and our hearts "united" to God, the Supreme Good. This is to pursue blessedness as in a chase.

Surgeon And Patient

When I was in Belfast I knew a doctor who had a friend, a leading surgeon there, and he told me that the surgeon's custom was, before performing any operation, to say to the patient, "Take a good look at the wound and then fix your eyes on me, and don't take them off till I get through the operation." I thought at the time that was a good illustration. Sinner, take a good

Jonah! You see, Jonah knew that while he was disobedient, he was still God's child. He knew his future was secure. He didn't fear death. As a matter of fact, he would rather die than obey! Have you ever had a child like that? Sleep Jonah Sleep, but remember God is awake!

JUMP JONAH JUMP

Many of God's prophets desired to die. Job begged God to take him. Elijah asked God to take him. There was nothing unusual about wanting to die. Sometimes living becomes very difficult, but God's people did not turn to suicide. They knew better than to take their own lives. Jonah told the men to throw him overboard and they would be alright. Why wouldn't Jonah just jump? If they threw him overboard, then they would be responsible for his death, not him! He could say to God, "I didn't do it; they did!" CRY JONAH CRY

As Jonah went overboard, he must have thought that he had gotten his way! He had chosen to die rather than obey. Surprise! Jonah never thought he would live. Jonah didn't like living in the belly of the whale! He felt like he was out of God's sight and his soul fainted, removing all strength and power from his life. He needed God! How many of God's children refuse to be merciful to others. A judgmental spirit is a spirit without mercy. God prepared a gourd, a worm and a vehement east wind and gave Jonah a lesson on mercy. God was still showing mercy to Jonah. God said, "Doest thou well to be angry?" Jonah declared that he was right to be angry. Jonah refused to say, "God, you are right and I am wrong." How sad!

Those who are obedient children, go away rejoicing, taking their sheaves with them. Those who remain disobedient, go away empty and pouting!!!! What's your spirit and where are your sheaves? By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil. Prov 16:6 Pout Jonah Pout and miss the blessings of God upon your life.
