We prove the will of God by walking in His footsteps. Are you more like Christ than you were at the time of your salvation? If not, your life hasn't been changed, or you are resisting the work of the Holy Spirit in your life. It burdens my heart to see so many people professing to belong to Christ and yet they live their lives by the world's standards. You can't take them at their word, because they do not keep their word. You cannot be sure they are being honest with you because it is their custom to lie. They live immoral lives and talk about their love for the Lord. We should be living by the same standard that Christ lived by. Of course we will not be perfect as He was, but we should be striving to live by the Word of God, just like Christ walked and lived by the Word of God. It should grieve our hearts to depart from godliness. We should be quick to repent and turn back to that we have been called to live in. Conviction and shame seem to be missing from the body of Christ today. Is it any wonder that the world is not looking to God today for their lives? What has the world seen in you and me that would make them desire to know God? Is God our provider, or do we do business as the world does business. When was the last time you prayed down a need instead of charging it? Do we live with the peace of God upon our lives, or do we live anxious like our neighbors live? Do we count it all joy when we fall into divers temptations, or do we act as if God was out to kill us?

Take a close look at your life. What do you see in you that looks like the Lord Jesus Christ? What do you see in yourself that would cause others to desire Christ? If Christ is not clearly seen in our lives the first people who are affected are our children and close family members. It is easy to convince your church family that you are a wonderful Christian, but the family knows the real you and those who do business with you during the week know if you truly do follow the ways of Christ.

We can be in the right place at the right time, doing the right thing and still be totally destroyed because of a wrong spirit. The will of God is for us to possess our vessels (bodies) in sanctification and honor. It is the heart of man

that God fellowships with. It is our responsibility to keep a right heart with God and God will get us to the right place at the right time and give us opportunity to do the right thing.

How are our hearts? Are they right with God? Are we clean vessels? Can the world see that we have been set apart for God's service, or do we just blend in with the rest of the crowd? Is the way we walk and talk bringing honor to the name of Christ? Are we walking in victory or destruction? If things are falling in around you, make sure it is because it is a testing and not because of ungodly living.

Now if we are going to follow Christ in our daily living there is one other thing we must do.

Then said Jesus unto his disciples, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow me.

For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for my sake shall find it.

It seems there is nothing but sin; God cares for you, He sent Jesus to win.

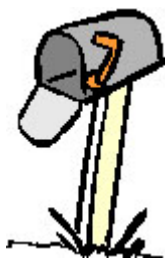

God's Holy Spirit, the Comforter comes in; And says over death that Jesus did win.

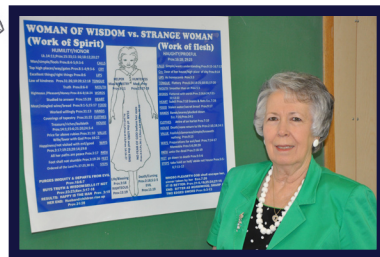
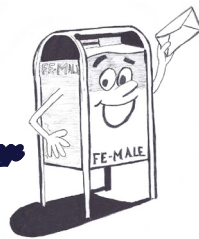

THE TREASURES OF CHILDBEARING!

And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression.

Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety.

1 Tim 2:14-15

I have learned to be thankful for being chosen to be a woman. Woman's position in creation is of great value to mankind when she lives her life in righteousness. She is the greatest destroyer when she lives her life in her own flesh and lives to fulfill herself, instead of others.

One of woman's weaknesses is that of deception. Our focus is mostly on the present things and because we do not look at the whole picture, we can easily be deceived. Our compassion and our mercy often blinds us from all the facts. Man is mostly thinking upon the end results and comes to a "matter of fact" conclusion, which is usually right, but often without compassion or mercy. Both man and woman struggle to walk right with the Lord. Our flesh is wicked and we cannot trust it. Godly men and women desire to walk right with the Lord, but they must be transformed into the image of Christ. God gives woman a special way in which to purge herself of deception and that is in childbearing.

Childbearing is the performance of maternal duties. Look around you and you will notice that just being able to bear a child does not make a woman a good mother. Just feeding, bathing and clothing that child will not keep a woman from deception. She must perform those duties in "faith", "charity", "holiness" and "sobriety". Ladies, I have raised three sons of my own and four daughters of other parents and I am here to tell you that daily living in faith, charity, holiness and sobriety is only done through dying to self.

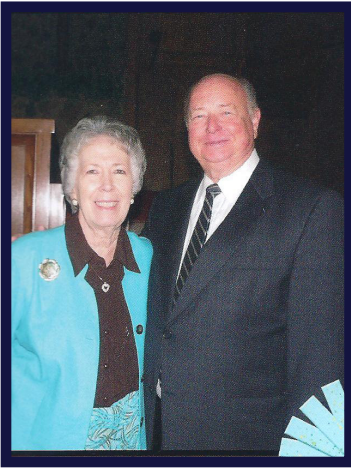
What does it mean to live in faith? You must first make sure that your faith is in the work of the Lord Jesus Christ and not yourself! He has the power, the strength and the wisdom to direct that child's life and by faith, we mothers, must trust that the Lord will empower us to do the work that the child needs to have in order to live a full rich life. We must have faith to believe the promises in the scriptures, but we must not misinterpret those promises to say what we want them to say. The verse, "Train up a child in the way he should go and when he is old he will not depart from it," is often misinterpreted. People think because they take the children to church every week that their children will never turn away from God. It doesn't say that. It says "train" up a child. When you train a child, that child not only hears the facts, but that child works the facts in their lives and experiences the results of doing right. They "taste" and see that the Lord is good and they will never be satisfied with anything less. Once you have tasted and seen that the way of the Lord is good, you hunger for that and are not satisfied to be without it. Most of the time we introduce our children to right, but we do not live those truths or we do not demand our children to live those truths and they never

taste the goodness of God. To talk about the peace of God and still live in upheaval at home does not teach our children the ways of God. Many children come to the conclusion that since you say you believe it, but you never accomplish it in your life, they conclude it is unattainable and they do not reach for it. There is much to be said about the meaning of "train up a child". Are your children convinced that your faith is real? Do they see you practice what you believe in hard times? Faith will make all the difference in your children's lives, but it will also change your life and open your eyes to see clearly.

The second step is to live your life with charity. When I hear the word love I always think of receiving, but when I hear the word charity I always think of giving. Are we really charitable? With what spirit do we give to others. Children demand a mother to be on duty twenty-four hours a day. When their needs dig into our time, what is our attitude. Do we complain and let them know they are a bother to us or do we serve their needs with a charitable attitude. Do they watch us complain about how much it cost us to serve others or do they know that we serve others because we love others.

What about "holiness"? To what extent will we go to be as much like Christ as possible. How far will we go from the world in order to draw nigh to God? Holiness is purity. How pure is our walk with God? I grew up in a very strict home. We did not go to movies, we did not listen to worldly music, we did not have a television and I could not wear pants. Some of my relatives were afraid my parents were

A LITTLE INFORMATION ABOUT TID BITS OF WISDOM

Bro. Jerry Brewster is the pastor of the Galilean Baptist Church in Cedar Hill, Texas. His wife Gloria is a Ladies Bible Teacher and counselor. Tid Bits of Wisdom is a ministry that they work through "The Wonderful Word Publishing Ministry". Mrs. Connine Cimino operates the tract and book ministry from Harlingen, Texas.

This page is usually given to tell about ministries of people that the Lord has mightily used in years past or in this present day. Jerry and I have published the Tid Bits of Wisdom for four full years now and realize that many who receive this little paper know nothing about us or our ministry, so please forgive us as we take a little space to share our hearts with you. We felt it was time to let you know something about the heart of this work. Since I do the putting together and the publishing of the paper, my husband felt I should write this article.

Jerry and I were very young when we married and had come from two very different backgrounds. I was raised inside of the church and knew very little about the world. My husband was raised out of the church, until he was about 12 years of age. At that time his step father was saved at a tent revival with Bro. Joe Boyd and his mother (said she was saved as a young girl) rededicated her life. It wasn't long after getting into church that the family moved to California and was out of church again for about 5 years. Before Jerry's family got into church he saw drinking and the things that go with the world. Jerry hated the way of the world. He wanted no part of it, but he did not deal with his own salvation until he was 32 years of age. He was the best church member there was. He served the church as Youth Pastor, bus worker, choir leader, Sunday School teacher and whatever the pastor needed, he did it. Jerry was not a man given to habits. He lived very clean. He loved the clean life. It was very hard for him when the Lord showed him he was a lost church man. He tried to convince the Lord of all his wonderful works, but the Lord would not accept them for salvation. My husband did not change any methods when he got saved, but his spirit was new and our children knew instantly that there was a change in daddy.

The fifteen years that I waited for Jerry to see his lost condition were very trying years for me. I was saved right after we began dating and when I got saved mine and Jerry's spirit could no longer relate to one another. God spoke to me and revealed to me that Jerry was religious but lost, yet I ignored that and justified going through with our marriage. God knew that he would use this to make and brake my life, so He did not block my way. God would use the pressure to purge me of religious self righteousness, which I had a lot of. God would use me to encourage Jerry to serve from his heart and not his head. Jerry had a stronger character than I did at that time. It was about four and a half years into our marriage that God broke me and I totally surrendered to His Word. God used Jerry and I to brake each other and then he built a love between us that nothing can break. We both are so thankful that we did not yield to our own understanding in those days and make decisions that we would be paying for today. God was faithful to bring us to fullness of life as we confessed and yielded to His working in our lives.

Today, we long to encourage others to follow Christ unto death, if necessary. It is better to die obedient, than to live in disobedience!

While the world created a hatred in Jerry for the things of the world, a hatred was created in me for hypocrisy in the church. I watched Christians fall by the wayside and stop serving the Lord, after having heard them teach and preach the truths of God. I didn't want to be that kind of a Christian. To me the worst thing a Christian could do was to turn back to the ways of the world. Yet I watched many do just that. Jerry was quick to show compassion to those who failed in the church and I was quick to be compassionate to the world. In time we helped each to see both sides of the coin and came to love those on both sides.

We learned to practice God's Word from the pew, without title other than Christian. God did not allow anything we did in the flesh to prosper. He would always bring us to our knees and today I am glad He did.

As we began to bear fruit and enjoy the benefits of obedience, we both had a hunger to share what we had found in Christ. This little paper is a way to do that. What we write about in this paper we have found in God's Word and in our daily walk with the Lord.

Jerry and I use the King James Version only and always will. We have many friends and loved ones who have taken other versions and we love them, but would warn them that this generation is walking in blindness and does not have the spiritual foresight to mess with our scriptures. My father had a third grade education and was very capable of reading and understanding the KJV. It is not difficult to understand. Many versions of the Bible bring confusion to the lost man. Which one is really the Bible? Satan is the author of confusion. Good men have been involved with these translations, but Satan is using this to bring confusion and to cause many to doubt that the Word of God is true and without error. At least 50% of the people who sit in church today do not believe that all of the Bible is true.

going to ruin my life. Every time I would visit them, they would let me know that if I wanted to do those things they would not tell my parents. Satan always makes a way to be disobedient if you want to. My parents were not legalistic and I am thankful for that. Their attitude was a desire to walk as close to the Lord as possible. When I married, mother and daddy got a television and for 30 years Jerry and I raised our children without a television. Jerry and I went to movies the first 5 years of our marriage and then we felt the Lord said to take that out of our lives. We have changed some of our ways through the years but we have always sought the Lord's leading as to what to remove from our lives and our home. Is holiness a part of your following the Lord? Holiness will keep you from deception!

The last thing is sobriety. Sobriety is nothing more than being "balanced". I believe this is the hardest thing to learn. I always think of the see saws we used to get on at the park. Most of the time we were either up or down. It was very hard to balance it in the middle where both were off the ground. When we live a balanced life we are not deceived. When we live a balanced life it is hard for anyone to find fault with our lives. When we are balanced, others feel our love in their lives, even though they know we hate the sin that is in their lives. We stand boldly in love and in righteous judgment. Our children know that whatever they do we will love them, but they also know that we will never participate in their sin or allow them to bring their sin into our home. We stand boldly against sin, but compassionate in love toward our children and loved ones.

When our children respect and appreciate our **faith**, they are convinced that we believe what we say we believe. When our children respect and appreciate our **charity**, they understand that it comes from our hearts and not our heads. When our children respect and appreciate our **holiness**, they will know that we do it because we love God and not because we are trying to impress God and others. When our children respect and appreciate our **sobriety**, they will want to be like us and will desire to follow what we have found in Christ. When we walk in these ways, not only are we spared from deception, but our children will hunger for what we have found in Christ.

Does this mean we will have perfect children? God has rebellious children. This does not mean that our children will not have struggles in their personal walks, but they will have honor and respect for who we are and what we believe. As long as we have their respect we have an open door to help when they are in need.

Raising godly children is the greatest work in life. You may not have captured the hearts of your children for God in their early days, but never give up. Where there is breath, there is hope. Die to self. Clean up your life and show them the power of God working through you. There is no greater work than training children to love God. As women, we have the best opportunity to form desires and hungers in our children for God and His Word.

I am thankful for the privilege of having a part in my children's lives. I am thankful for what they have taught me as I attempted to raise them. Of all the works the Lord has allowed us to do, our children are the greatest work we possess. We went through some very hard times bringing our children to adulthood and now they will more than likely go through some very hard times watching over elderly parents. It's the hard times that make us or break us. It's the hard times that reveal us to God and others. I pray for every young couple as they begin their families, that they will let God make them into vessels of honor so their children will hunger to know the God that we have come to love so much.
