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PROVIDER FATHER


The months of May and June are the months we celebrate our mothers and our fathers. It's our effort to show our appreciation and our honor for what they have invested in our lives. If nothing else, the fact that they gave us life.

Not every mother or father have lived their lives in an honorable way. The damage they brought to the lives of their families is sometimes more obvious than the good they might have done for their families. We live in a day when families are not accomplishing what God created them to accomplish. Because of this, there is confusion in the street, in our churches and our government. We are living like people who have been raised in the jungles, without education or understanding. We have education on every corner, but our education is not making us act with wisdom. Our country has departed from the God who has blessed us and given us all our benefits. Why do we have violence in the streets? Why would a policeman do harm to a victim he is paid to protect? Why would a pastor preach the truth and then violate that truth in his daily life? We have the Word of God in our hands but not in our hearts or our lives. Because of this, our families are broken, and just like Eve, instead of being "Help Meets" to one another, we are "helping to destroy" one another.

The family was designed to represent the image of the godhead. The godhead is our example of what God created us to be in our families. The father represents the Heavenly Father. The father is the PROVIDER of the family. This does not mean that the women cannot provide for the family. It means that God holds the father responsible for the provisions. The virtuous woman in Proverbs 31 is a very productive woman and causes the husband's goods to increase. While her work produces increase, God never intended her to bear the burden of the necessary provisions. Both husband and wife are to work toward the building of the home. Both positions should bring growth and increase.

A wrong prespective concerning money is often the reason for a broken home. The LOVE of money is the root of all evil (destruction). When a man takes a wife and she takes his name, she becomes a JOINT heir. What's his is hers and what's hers is his! They are ONE! The Word (Jesus) has access to all the



Father has! The Father is in charge of the distribution, but it belongs to both. Many husbands will not release ownership of their money when it comes to marriage. Many women will not release ownership of their money and the two never work as one. When both husband and wife are working outside of the home there is often a contest between who is the best supporter and then feeling they have more rights if they contribute more money. You cannot work as one authority when everything is judged by who supplies the most money.

The greatest thing that ever happened to our marriage was when we sought how to handle our money in a way that would bring glory to God. Some husbands are excellent at handling money. They have a right attitude about it, they give God what is rightfully His, they pay their bills on time and they do not use it to manipulate their wife and children. Others struggle with needs that would keep them from being a good provider. No one can tell you how you are to handle your finances. There is not a right or wrong way, but there are right and wrong principles concerning the way you respond and spend your money. Too often we attempt to set down rules and regulations as to how every one should handle their

money. My wife went to a seminar some years ago and the woman teacher said a wife should never write a check. She said that only the man should handle the finances. Many women went home thinking that if they helped their husbands with the finances they wouldn't be submissive wives. I happen to be a man who needs a secretary. My wife does my office work when it comes to money. I am the responsible party and she carries out my orders. I get wrapped up in the daily work and often forget about what day it is and when it is that the bills come due. For years I also had an expense account that I handled and it was helpful to me to have my wife take care of the home finances. All that I have is ours and it's to her advantage to do a good job as my secretary. When we come up short with the finances she will say, "You have a problem!" I bear the burden; she does the paper work. If you see you need help, don't have so much pride that you can't ask for help. Just remember, do not put the burden of finances on your wife. One of the greatest tests to knowing if you have a right attitude about money is how you give God what is rightfully his. Until you tithe with a cheerful heart, money is too important to you. God designed the man to provide for the home. There are many needs of a home and not all of those needs are money.

The father is also the husband or husbandry. He plants the seed and then it is his responsibility to tend to the plant. He is to till the soil, to water and prune and take care of the cleaning of the plant. He is the saviour of the body. (Eph. 5:23) That means, he is the deliverer of the body. He is to protect.

If you are going to protect someone, you are going to have to pay attention to their needs. Most men do not even know what their wife's needs are. You would have to be close in heart to be able to do this properly. Have you ever passed by a yard and just been amazed at how neat and clean kept it looks? What about the yard where it looks like they only do what is necessary to keep the city from giving them a citation. A lot of husbands only do what they can get away with. They don't realize that the life of the woman is a reflection of the man. They are ONE. What kind of a reputation does your family have. Are they a picture of chaos or organization? Happy or murmurers? Enjoying the journey or just putting up with life?

You may be a great provider, but the most important thing a father should do is to LOVE his family. Love never fails! You might say, "You don't understand; my wife is not a lovable person." If your wife has a problem being lovable, it doesn't excuse you for being unlovable. Anyone can love the lovely. A husband is to love his wife as Christ loved the church. Christ died for the church when we were yet sinners!!! He took the first step. He was our example. In most marriages today the father and mother simply put up with one another. Few children are raised in a home of LOVE.

Take a good look at your home. Does LOVE live inside your home? What kind of relationship do you and your wife have? You may fulfill all your responsibilities with your hands, but do you fulfill your responsibilities with your heart? How does she feel about your love for her? Have you convinced her that her life is as important to you as yours is? Have you found balance between serving and ruling your house? Do you know how to be gentle and strong at the same time? Is your leadership anything like God's leadership to us? You were created to exhibit the image of God to your wife and children.

Does your family see you as a person who keeps his word? One of the best ways to show God in your life is to be a man of your word. God never breaks His Word to us. We will fail, but when we fail, do we quickly make it right with our family? One of the joys about serving our God is knowing that what He says He will do.

There is nothing as great as a great father. A great father is a father who concerns himself with the needs of his family. Being poor is not bad, but being poor and no one cares that you are poor is bad. You may only have a dollar, but if your family knows that you are working at it and that their needs matter to you, your family will feel secure with that dollar. It's not the amount of provisions that matter to a family. It is the heart of the one providing that makes the difference.

This Father's Day, more than likely, your children will honor you for being their father. Will you take a look as to what kind of a father you have been and commit yourself to allowing God to make you a great father so you can bring glory to God your Father?

My father left home before I was born. I never got to see the greatness that he could have been to us children, because his life was more important to him than our lives were. I'm sorry he missed a lot of wonderful years we could have had together as a family. I'm thankful for the life he gave me, but I wish I could have seen him as a father to us kids. I have the privilege of being the father to three sons and four foster daughters. May God help me to encourage and to bless their lives.

Remember, the father is the **PROVIDER**, the mother is the **PRODUCER**, and the children are the **PRODUCTS!** There is no work greater than the work of the family.




PRODUCER - MOTHER

Those are domestic works and they are only the outward actions of a mother. A mother has the opportunity to change the world! The way we teach our children and the way we encourage our husbands creates the world we live in. Do you like the world you live in? Do something about it. Make a difference!

The woman's position in the family is the same that Jesus (The Word) is in the godhead. The Word humbled himself and became like us so he could show us how to live. He sacrificed himself so we could be with the Father, as He was. Wow! He really loved us, did He not? What kind of love do we exhibit as wives and mothers? If we fail as wives and mothers, it is because we would not humble ourselves as Christ did. We're not going to be under someone we are equal to! That is beneath us! Our pride destroys us. How do we feel toward Christ for what He did for us? His name is above all names. We see what He did for us as the greatest thing a person could do. Then why do we feel that what God asks us to do is degrading. It is every bit as great as what Christ was doing for us. We all live because of what Christ did and if you want your family to live, you must do your life like Christ did.

Jesus is the producer of the godhead. Jesus said in Him was life. The woman was created with life (milk) in her so she could give life to her children. How to walk, how to talk, how to feed themselves, how to control their tempters, how to respond to others, etc. A mother prepares a child for life. Why are the children rioting in the streets today? Because they were "left to themselves" when it came to character. Mother either didn't care, or she was off to work and they were left to baby-sitters who didn't feel it was their responsibility. When I see an out of control anger on the road I always wonder, "Did their mother or father not teach them to have self control?" My father would spank me and then say, "You can cry, but cry softly." I was not allowed to throw a fit. I could speak what I thought



as long as I spoke with respect. Self control is the secret to a successful life. I see adults every day who still have no self control in their lives and they are destroying everything they touch.

A mother, who is controlling her life, and not her life controlling her, can be a mother who makes a difference in her generation.

A mother should teach her children to live by the ten commandments. How does she teach them? By obeying the ten commandments. A mother should teach her children to have right attitudes. How does she teach this? By making sure she has a right attitude about all things. A mother should teach her children how to love. How does she do this? By the way she responds to their needs and by the way she responds to their father's needs. Also, by how she treats her friends. As the singer, Bro. Johnny Flannagan would say, "Your talk talks and your walk talks, but your walk talks louder than you talk talks." A personal example will encourage the world around you to do that which is right.

family. She is more valuable than the stock market! She takes the provisions that her husbands gives her and makes them to grow into great provisions. Proverbs says that the man who has this woman for his wife will have no need of "spoil". Spoil is what the men took when they were in battle. They could take whatever a person owned if they conquered him in war, but the virtuous woman's husband had no need for spoil, because she had done such a good job of taking care of his provisions. He didn't have to take that second and third job to make ends meet.

You might check yourself out and see if what you are doing is benefiting the family. It costs to go to work. You must have a second car, extra insurance, baby-sitting money, clothes to wear to work and eat out when you are too tired to cook. You might be more productive at home. Whatever or however God says for you to accomplish your responsibilities, remember, your heart is to be in your home. That's where your life is. When you take care of home, then you are free to pursue other things, "as unto the Lord" of course.

The home was intended to be the place of power. It is supposed to be like a battery charger. It is to charger us with what we need to meet the day, whatever it brings. Home is where we learn to live by conviction and principles. If your home has never laid the foundation of these two things then you and the children are left to the wind and you will go wherever the wind blows. A father needs to be put on the spot and have to make his will known to his wife. How else can she do his will? I fear too many homes are the way we started our home years ago. I remember looking out on the school yard and seeing Jerry and thinking to myself that he would do perfectly as my husband. He was what I wanted. I never considered if I were what he needed. It was all about my life; not his! How wrong for a woman to start out. There were many things about our lives that just did not fit together. We are as different as day light and dark. We didn't have the wisdom to check these things out, we just knew that we liked each other and had a great time together. After marriage we realized we were worlds apart on how to live life. GEORGE MULLER'S Advise to Preachers

That which I now considered the best mode of preparation for the public ministry of the Word, from deep conviction, and from the experience of God's blessing upon it, is as follows: I ask the Lord that He would graciously be pleased to teach me on what subject I shall speak, or what portion of His Word I shall expound. Sometimes it happens that a subject, or a passage, has been in my mind; in that case I ask Him whether I should speak on it. If after prayer I feel persuaded that I should, I fix upon it, yet so that I would desire to leave myself open to the Lord to change it, if He please. Frequently, however, it occurs that I have no text or subject in my mind before I give myself to prayer. In this case I wait some time for an answer, trying to listen to the voice of the Spirit to direct me. If then a passage or subject, I again ask Him, and that sometimes repeatedly, whether it be His will I should speak on it. Frequently it happens that I not only have no text or subject, but also do not obtain one after once or twice, or more times, praying about it. What I do is

to go on with my regular reading of the Scriptures, praying whilst I read, for a text. I have even had to go to the place of meeting without a text, and obtained it perhaps only a few minutes before I was going to speak; but I have never lacked the Lord's assistance at the time of preaching, provided I had earnestly sought it in private.

Now when the text has been obtained, whether it be one or two or more verses, or a whole chapter, I ask the Lord that He would graciously be pleased to teach me by His Holy Spirit, whilst meditating over it. Within the last sixty-three years (1895) I have found it the most profitable plan to meditate with my pen in my hand, writing down the outlines, as the Word is opened to me. This I do for the sake of clearness, as being a help to see how far I understand the passage. I very seldom use any other help besides the little I understand of the original of the Scriptures, and some good translations in other languages. My chief help is prayer. I have never in my life begun to study one single part of divine truth without gaining some light about it, when I have been able really to give myself to prayer and meditation over it. This I most firmly believe, that no one ought to expect to see much good resulting from his labours if he is not much given to prayer and meditation.

Simplicity of expression, while the truth is set forth, is of the utmost importance. It should be the aim of the teacher so to speak, that children, servants, and people who cannot read may be able to understand him, so far as the natural mind can comprehend the things of God. It should also be considered, that if the preacher strive to speak according to the rules of this world, he may please many, particularly those who have a literary taste, but in the same proportion he is less likely to become an instrument in the hands of God for the conversion of sinners or for the building up of the saints. For neither eloquence nor depth of thought makes the truly great preacher, but
